Availability is dependant on the musician's travel schedule. At times, the rigorous travel schedule and demands of tour make it impossible for Marine Band musicians to conduct clinics/master classes. Musicians are most likely to be available in your city the morning after the concert. Clinics/master classes must be free and open to the public and musicians cannot accept a fee or honorarium.
